1. Prayer for Israel

For restored unity among the Israeli People

Pray that Israel will emerge from the High Holy Days with a sense of restored unity and healing among the people. Pray for a wise, fair and widely-accepted compromise to the judicial reforms dispute. Pray that the Israeli military will remain strong and vigilant against all threats, and that everyone will return to serving their reserve duty in the IDF. Pray that Israel's enemies would not mistakenly try to take advantage of the Jewish fall holidays or the internal debate over judicial reforms to attack Israel. Finally, pray for the Bedouin communities in Israel, who often feel neglected by Israel and used as pawns by Palestinian and European leaders.

For More New Embassies to Open in Jerusalem

Praise the Lord for the new nations which have announced plans to open embassies in Jerusalem, including Papua New Guinea, Paraguay, Fiji, Sierra Leone, and Congo. Pray that these and other countries would move quickly to place their embassies in Jerusalem.

For Christians in Israel

Pray for the Lord's protection over the Believers in Israel, that they would be bold and steadfast when faced with attempts to harass and harm them. Thank God that Israeli authorities have agreed to resume issuing all the needed staff visas to Christians organizations based in the Land, such as the ICEJ. Pray for Jerusalem to remain open as a "house of prayer for all nations".

2. Prayer for the Region and the Nations

For a Breakthrough in Israel-Saudi Relations

Continue praying for a diplomatic breakthrough in relations between Israel and Saudi Arabia, along the lines of the Abraham Accords which normalized relations between Israel and several Arab states in recent years. Pray that Israel would not have to compromise or cede its historic rights and claims to Jerusalem and Judea/Samaria in order to secure a peace deal with Riyadh. Pray that more nations around the world would befriend Israel and stand with the Jewish state in international forums.

For an End to the Iranian Threat to Israel

Pray for the Lord to deal with the radical Islamist regime in Iran, which is committed to Israel's destruction and is coming dangerously close to developing nuclear weapons capabilities that would allow it to carry out its genocidal plans against the Jewish state and people. Pray that all international controls over Iran's nuclear facilities would be restored. Pray that Iran would be thwarted in its many efforts to attack Israel and Israelis abroad through regional proxy militias and global terror networks. Pray that the Iranian people would succeed in setting a new course for their nation free of the dictates of the radical Ayatollahs now ruling in Tehran.

Pray that our Israeli guests will be deeply impacted by the Feast. Pray for more online viewers. Finally, pray that there would be no violent protests against the Feast.
